## Presentations and Language

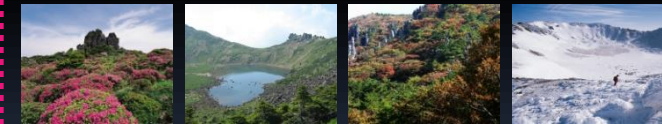
- All the presentations will be made on invitation base. English is the official language of the workshop and will be used for all printed materials, presentations and discussions.
