Postgraduate Students in the Centre for the Enhancement of Teaching and Learning (Open Position)

The University of Hong Kong (HKU) is committed to the highest international standards of excellence in teaching and research, and has been at the international forefront of academic scholarship for many years. There are 28,000 undergraduate and postgraduate students who are recruited globally, and more than 2,000 members of academic and academic-related staff coming from multi-cultural backgrounds, many of whom are internationally renowned.

The Centre for the Enhancement of Teaching and Learning (CETL) in The University of Hong Kong (HKU) is recruiting MPhil/PhD students to start around Sep 2018, to be enrolled in the Faculty of Education which has been ranked number four among the top Education faculties worldwide by the Times Higher Education (THE) World University Rankings for Education 2018.

We are looking for a highly motivated and creative undergraduate or graduate student who is interested in higher education and educational pedagogical related research. The successful applicant will be supervised by Dr. Cecilia Chan (<http://www.cetl.hku.hk/about-us/academic-staff/dr-cecilia-ky-chan/>), who is the Head of Professional Development and an Associate Professor in CETL. He/She will conduct research as a member of the Teaching and Learning Enhancement and Research Group (TLERG) (<http://tlerg.cetl.hku.hk/>) led by Dr. Chan, and will have the opportunity to work closely with Dr. Chan and her team consisting of a project leader, a post-doctoral fellow, research assistants and postgraduate students.

Areas of research in the research group include (1) assessment and feedback, (2) the development and assessment of generic competencies (e.g. critical thinking, teamwork, communication skills), (3) experiential learning and (4) engineering education.

Applicants should have a recognized undergraduate degree in Education or relevant Social Sciences field and meet the Postgraduate admission criteria for The University of Hong Kong. The successful applicant should have good research skills, communication skills, interpersonal and organizational skills; and the ability to work independently as part of a team responsibly. An excellent command of spoken and written English is a must.
